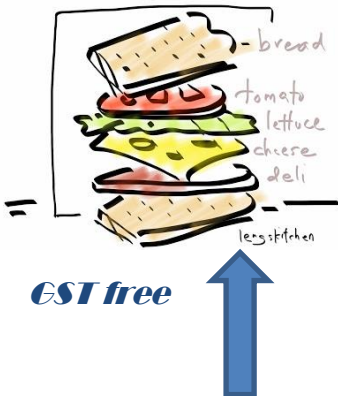
### Healthy Eating – for energy and to help boost the immune system
